

Ring Size Guide


Before printing, please make sure the paper is in A4 size & scaled to 100%. You can check the accuracy of your print by positioning a credit card on the line below.

If the card lines up, you're all set.

Option 1: Using an Existing Ring

Match the inside of your existing ring with one of the circles below. When your ring has been placed on the right size, you should see only the white area - inside your ring. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.



Method 2: Using Fan Silver Jewelry Ruler

After you cut out the ruler, carefully cut the line to create a slit. Wrap the ruler around your finger at the base and pull the tapered end through the slit. To make sure the ring will fit comfortably, we suggest also measuring your knuckle. We recommend selecting a size that goes on and off your finger easily.

After measuring, subtracting the result by 40 will give you the desired ring size.

(For example: the result is 52 cm, so your ring size is 52 - 40 = 12)

Ring size may also vary slightly depending on style of the ring.
